**Corporal:** (CORE-pore-uhl, from the Latin *corpus*, meaning "body") a square of white linen cloth, now usually somewhat smaller than the breadth of the altar, upon which the chalice and paten, and also the ciborium (containing the smaller hosts for the Communion of the laity), are placed during the celebration of the Mass.
